Touch of Love Outreach: Brief Overview

We are a charitable organisation set up to feed local Aberdeen and Aberdeenshire homes experiencing real hardship by meeting their most basic need for food through the weekly provision of a 3-day emergency food supply, while a longer-term solution is developed.

We provide both warm meals and raw food in our food parcels to families in hardship. We help anybody who needs our support, including the young, elderly, single people and families from all backgrounds, religious beliefs and ethnic origin without prejudice. There is no charge for the food we provide. Our food parcels are delivered to people's homes per request as we are conscious that some people would like their anonymity and dignity protected. There is also the option for collection from our base.

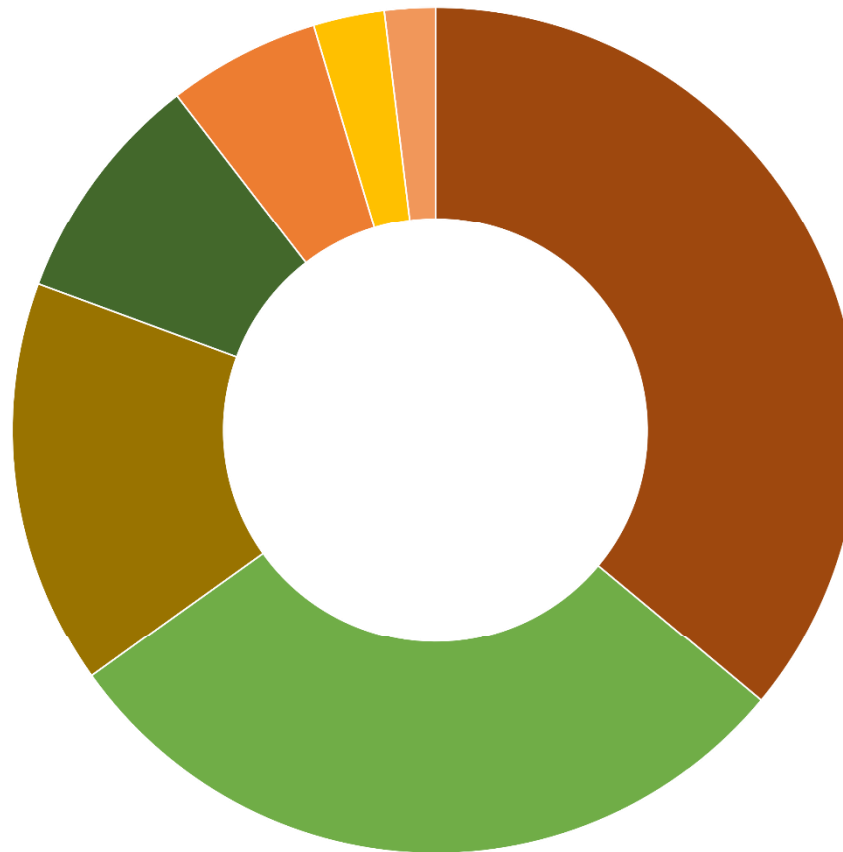

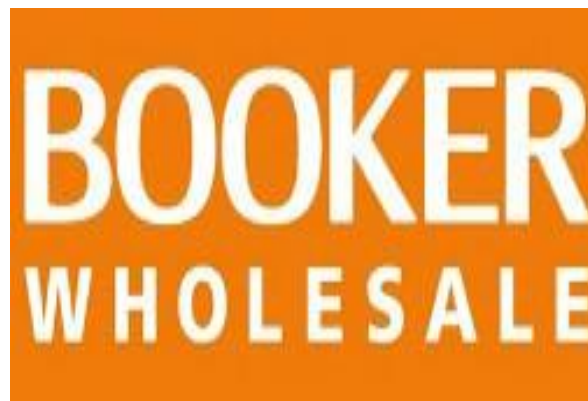

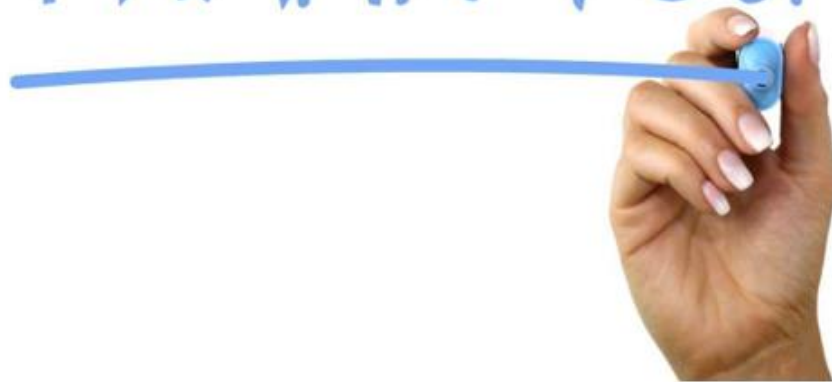
