Addressing EDI Concerns:

To address concerns related to equity, diversity, and inclusion (EDI) within Touch of Love Outreach, individuals are encouraged to follow a structured process that ensures every issue is acknowledged and addressed with sensitivity and urgency:

1. Immediate Reporting:

 Report any EDI concerns directly to a designated EDI Officer or any trusted member of the management team. If uncomfortable, individuals may approach the Board of Trustees directly.

2. Confidential Submission:

 Individuals are encouraged to document their concerns in writing, detailing the incident(s), including times, dates, and witnesses. This documentation supports a thorough review process.

3. Assurance of Confidentiality:

• All reports are treated with strict confidentiality, with information shared only among those essential to the resolution process.

4. Thorough Investigation:

• The organization commits to a prompt, fair investigation of all EDI concerns, employing impartiality. External experts or consultants might be involved to ensure a comprehensive approach.

5. Support and Resources:

 Touch of Love Outreach provides support to all parties involved during the investigation process, offering access to counselling services or other resources as needed.

6. Transparent Resolution:

 Upon investigation completion, findings and subsequent actions taken will be communicated to the complainant, ensuring transparency and closure.

7. Right to External Escalation:

• Should individuals feel the resolution is unsatisfactory, they are supported in escalating the concern to external bodies, such as EDI regulatory authorities or legal counsel.

Touch of Love Outreach is committed to fostering an inclusive environment where diversity is celebrated, and equity is pursued. We maintain an open-door policy for addressing EDI concerns, ensuring our community is a space where every individual feels valued, heard, and respected.
